

## Jubilee Ministry Centers of the Episcopal Church

Jubilee Ministry, created in 1982 by General Convention in New Orleans, heralded a new era of work for the Episcopal Church. Jubilee Ministry was mandated through a resolution as a ministry of joint discipleship with poor and oppressed people wherever they are found, to meet basic human needs and build a just society.

Currently there are over 650 Jubilee Ministry Centers in the Episcopal Church; these community-based centers are involved in outstanding ministry/ programs throughout the country; they are Churches, organizations, and/or agencies of the Episcopal Church who are involved in a ministry of empowerment, evangelism, advocacy and/or direct social service.

Each Jubilee Ministry Center strengthens the Community and reminds neighboring communities of more possibilities for living out the Gospel mandate as expressed in Luke 4:18-19 and Matthew 25:34-40.

## Jubilee 2000 Curriculum *The Year of the Lord's Favor*

**JPIC** - A committee of Executive Council which was established in 1995 to serve in an advisory capacity and to be known as the Justice, Peace, and Integrity of Creation Advisory Committee.

JPIC was to have subcommittees for Anti-Racism, Global Peace and Justice, and Economic Justice, Environmental Stewardship, etc. for the purpose of facilitating communication and collaboration between the Executive Council and ministries throughout the Episcopal Church which address issues of peace, social and economic justice and the environment.

At the 1997 General Convention meeting in Philadelphia, PA a resolution was passed which called for the development and implementation of educational materials to promote the declaration that the year 2000 be a Jubilee Year and that the Church commit to Jubilee imperatives of debt forgiveness, environmental stewardship, and human liberation.
