**NEW MUSIC VIDEO ON EPISCOPAL CHURCH WEBSITE**

A new music video, featuring the United States Army Chorus, is now available on the multimedia page of the Episcopal Church website: [www.episcopalchurch.org/page/multimedia](http://www.episcopalchurch.org/page/multimedia).

The video was filmed on October 3, at St. John's Episcopal Church, Lafayette Square, in Washington, D.C., and features sacred music by Vincent Persichetti and Leonard Bernstein, as well as a medley of sea shanties, story songs by Edward MacDowell, Wagner's "Pilgrims' Chorus," and "The Battle Hymn of the Republic."

Located across from the White House, St. John's, Lafayette Square, is known as "the Church of the Presidents" because, since its first service in October 1816, every president of the United States has attended a service at St. John's.
